The Women Cell of Jhanji Hemnath Sarma College in association with NSS Unit, Jhanji Hemnath Sarma College organised a meeting at Jamuguri Lower Primary School, Jamuguri on 8th March, 2023 on account of International Women's Day. In this meeting, elderly women from the nearby areas were invited. The main purpose of this meeting was to create an awareness against the use of intoxicating substances by women along with felicitation of five elderly women of the locality. Mr. Dwijen Dutta, retired health personnel was invited as the resource person for the meeting. The meeting was presided by Dr. Manjit Gogoi, Principal, Jhanji Hemnath Sarma College. The meeting commenced with the felicitation of Mr. Dwijen Dutta, Dr. Manjit Gogoi and Mrs. Pranati Phukan, headmistress of Jamuguri Lower Primary School. The objective behind the meeting was elaborated by Mrs. Minati Gogoi, Associate Professor, Dept. of Economics before the invited guests for the meeting. The resource person in his speech stated the consumption of intoxicating substance by women not only hampers a woman's family but also has adverse effect on the society by way of values instilled by the former in their children. He discouraged the use of such substance and asked everyone to divert from such use by resorting to spirituality. The spirit of the meeting was more uplifted with the poem recital of Dr. Santana Dutta, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Sociology that reflected the life of women. The meeting continued with the felicitation of five elderly guests- Amiya Saikia, Archana Duarah, Rupa Chetia, Renu Das and Dangor Aaiti Das with assamese traditional Gamusa and a gift. The guests were kind enough to express their views along with showcasing some of their talents, notably, Archana Duarah's assamese traditional borgeet performance, Usha borpuhari's recital of a poem and Hiranya Acharjya's singing performance. Dr. Manjit Gogoi also enriched the guests with his views and experience on the subject. The vote of thanks was delivered by Mrs. Navanita Bora, Associate Professor, Dept. of Assamese in which she thanked the headmistress of the school for providing the venue, the invited guests for their presence and participation, the resource person for his valuable time and respected principal of the college for his support towards organising such an event.
