He focused on aspects like what is IPR, why it is important and how it is related to marketisation. He explained that they provide legal protection for creative and innovative work, encouraging investment in research and development. IPR, including patents, trademarks, and copyrights, incentivize businesses to innovate, leading to economic growth and job creation. He highlighted that they also protect the rights of creators, fostering a competitive and fair marketplace. In a knowledge-based economy, IPR plays a pivotal role in driving innovation, safeguarding innovation's value, and ensuring a level playing field for businesses and individuals, making it highly relevant for the contemporary market and global economy.

Throwing light on the concepts of transformative work, different aspects of copyright in social media, etc. he discussed how these facets transcends in to the digital academic contents that mostly includes journal articles. The copyright agreements of major publishing houses were discussed and how practicing 'Fair Use' can avert one from copyright infringement. He also demonstrated on different types of creative commons licenses. Citing the UGC regulation, 2018 on the promotion of academic integrity, the resource person demonstrated on levels of plagiarism, which mostly leads to copyright infringement in academia. He informed about the promotion of the plagiarism detection tool 'Drillbit' by the UGC towards the conclusion of the session.






