ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION

Goal: Environment plays an important role in healthy living and the existence of life on planet earth. All living species are dependent on the environment for food, air, water and other needs. Therefore, it is important for every individual to save and protect our environment. As a part of society, educational institutions should play a pivotal role regarding protection of environment. Jhanji Hemnath Sarma College, takes some initiatives towards the protection of environment along with its regular academic activities. By following the famous quote, 'Save the environment, the future is in your hands', Jhanji Hemnath Sarma College has been working for environmental protection through different cells and wings.

Context: Man and environment are interrelated. The environment influences the life of human beings and also human beings modify their environment. Rapid deforestation has hugely contributed to air and soil pollution along with disruption of biodiversity. As an impact of population explosion there has been increasing instances of land encroachment which leads to depletion of greenery. Industrialization have also contributed to these adverse effects. The institution is located by the side of National highway 37. Construction activity to extend the highway from two lane to four lane have resulted in felling of a large number of trees. Through different plantation activity in the locality, the institution attempts to create awareness among the people to extend their efforts towards afforestation. Moreover, as an attempt to protect the environment the college-initiated plantation programme as a regular activity in different localities. Because without plantation we can not purify our environment.

The Practice: The College observes International Environment Day every year to promote environmental awareness among its stakeholders. Various awareness programmes on environmental issues such as plantation, cleanliness, health check-up, etc. are organised by different cells and wings of the college.

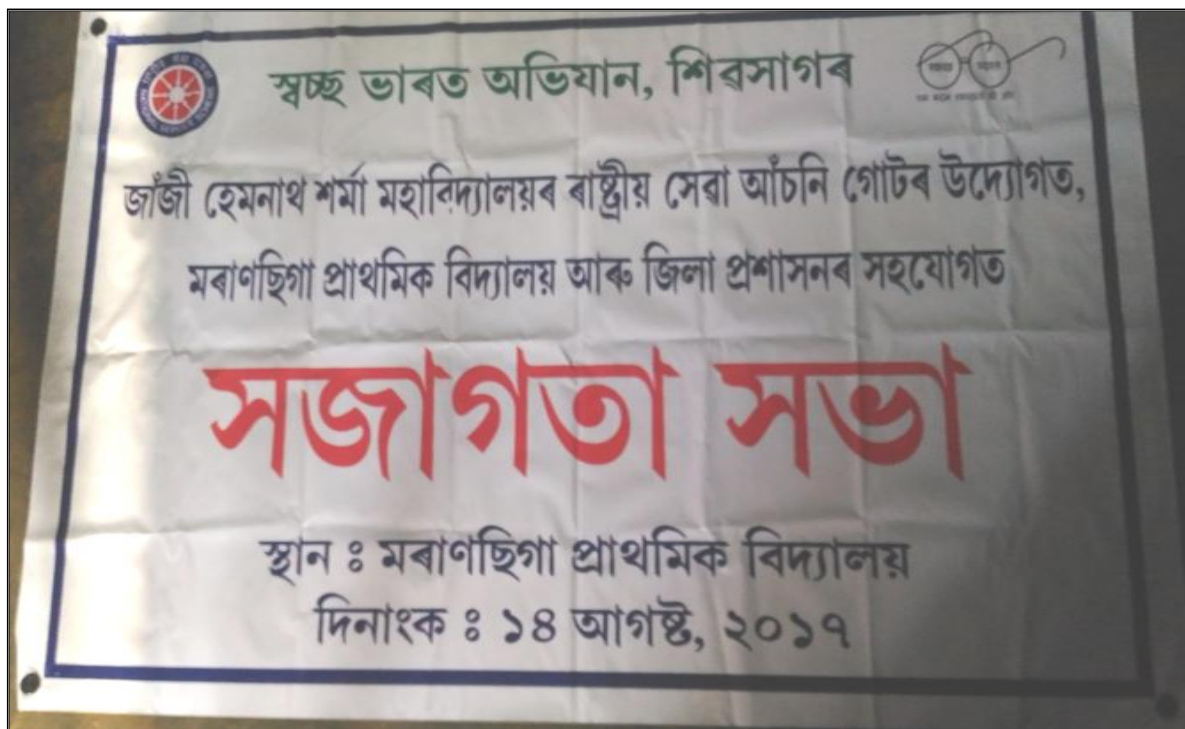

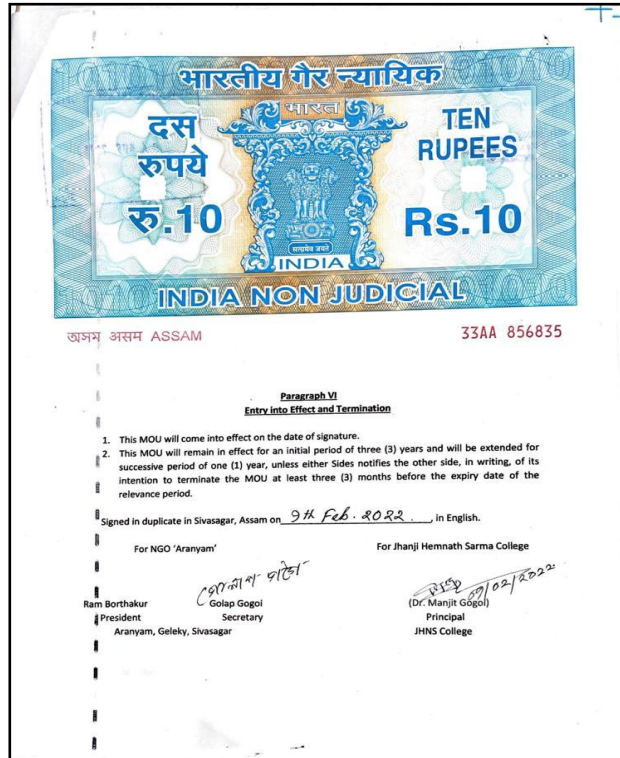
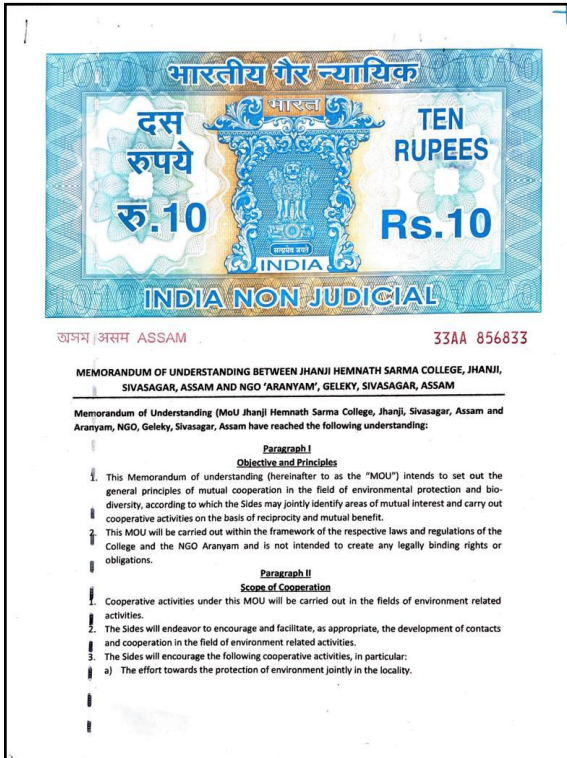
