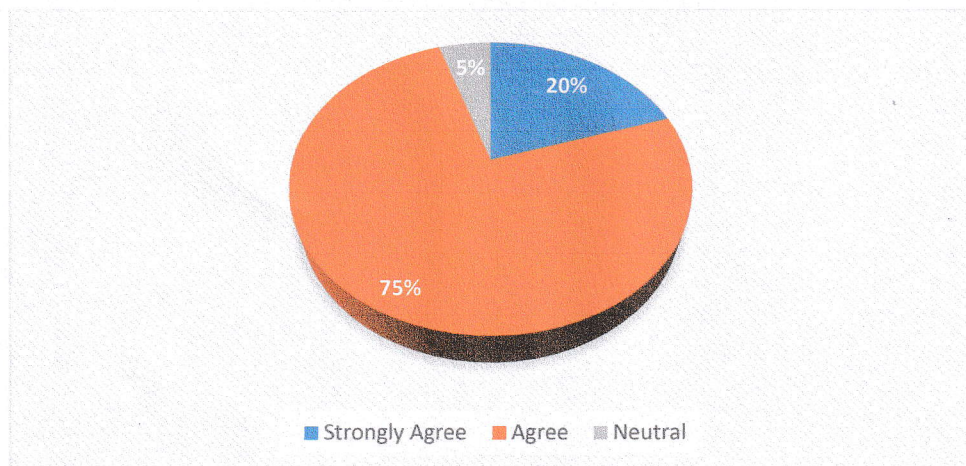


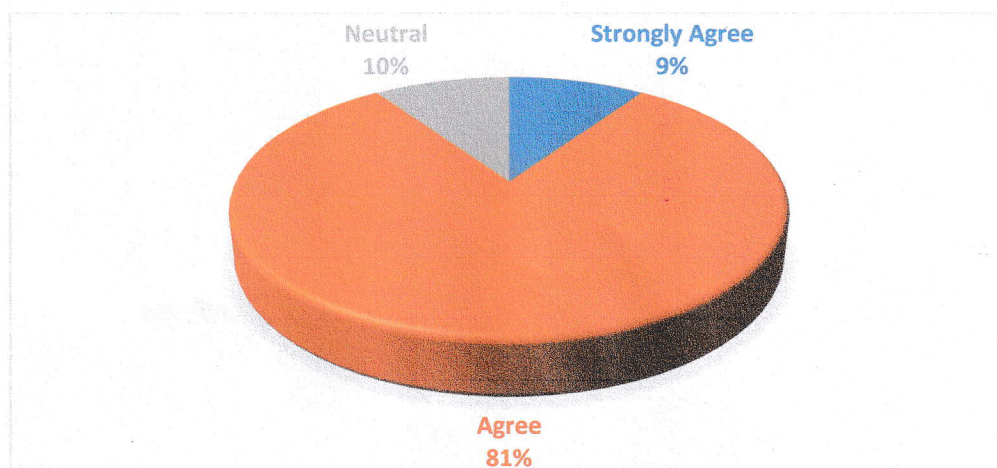
Faculty Feedback Report

1. The courses/ subjects taught to the students are up-to-date

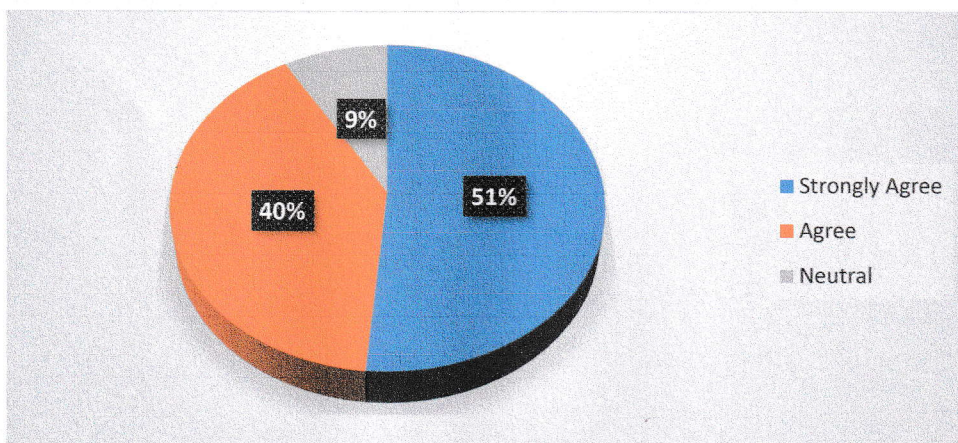


2. Syllabus is sufficient to bridge the gap between current global scenarios and academics

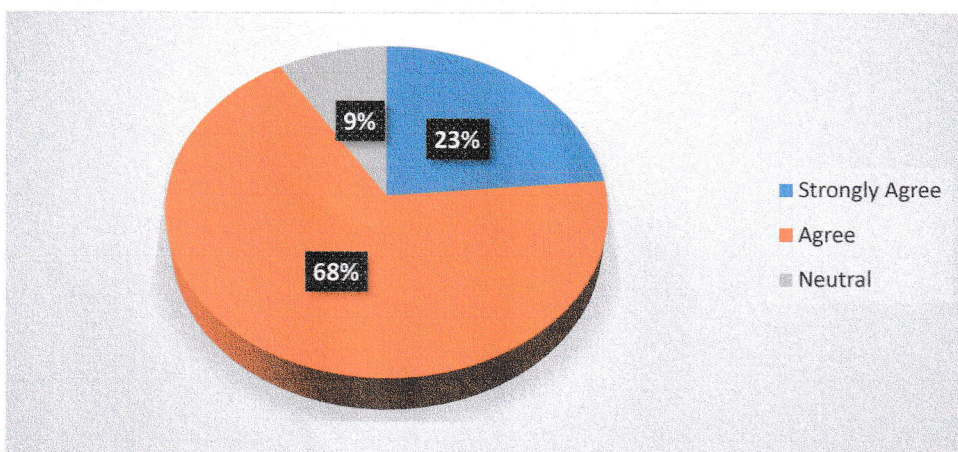

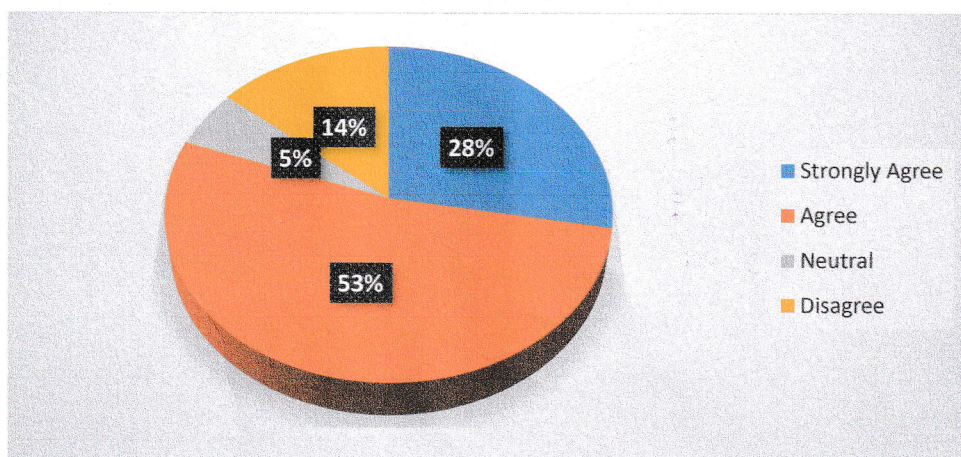
3. The courses have the focus both theoretically and practically



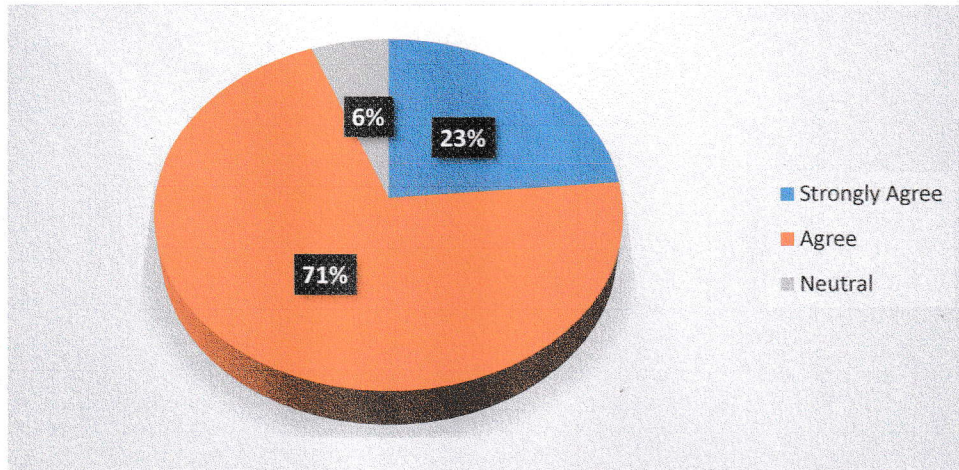
4. The depth of the course content is adequate to have significant learning outcome



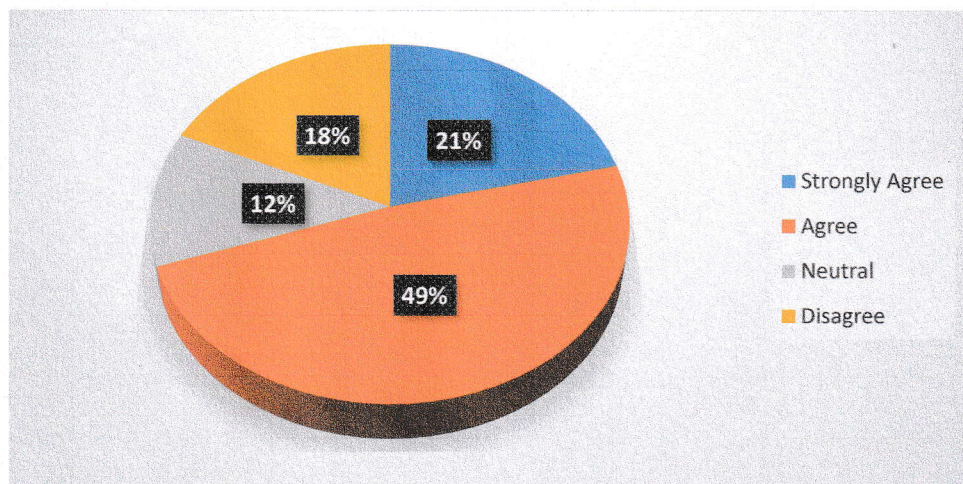
5. The reference books/ journals listed in the syllabus are relevant and cover whole syllabus



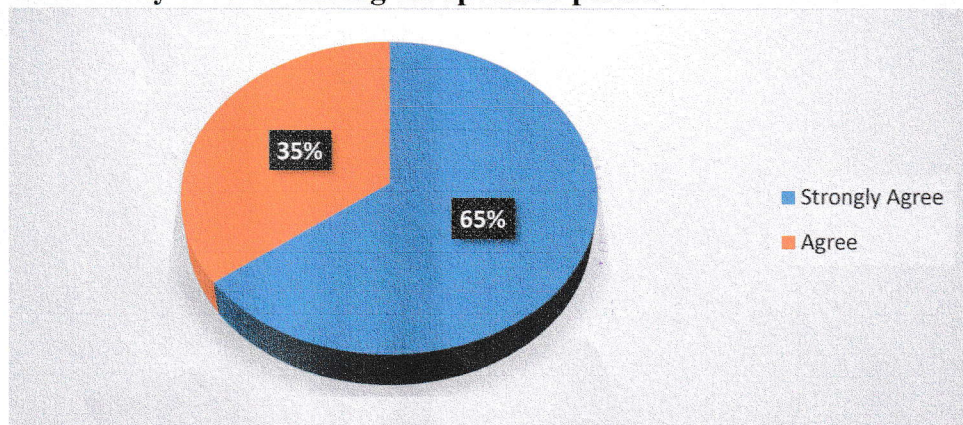
6. Innovative practices are adopted for teaching

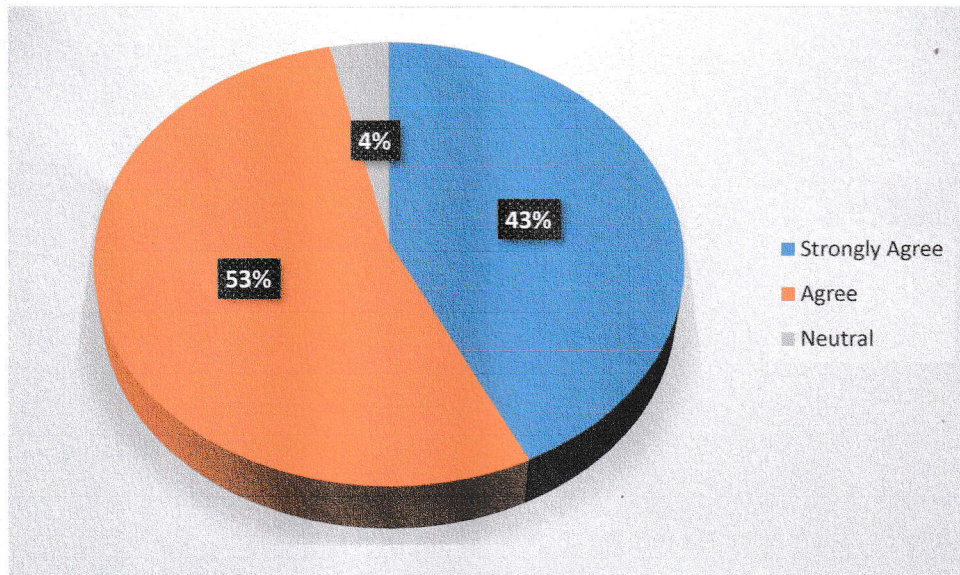


7. Sufficient learning material such as books, e-books, journals etc. are available in the college/ library

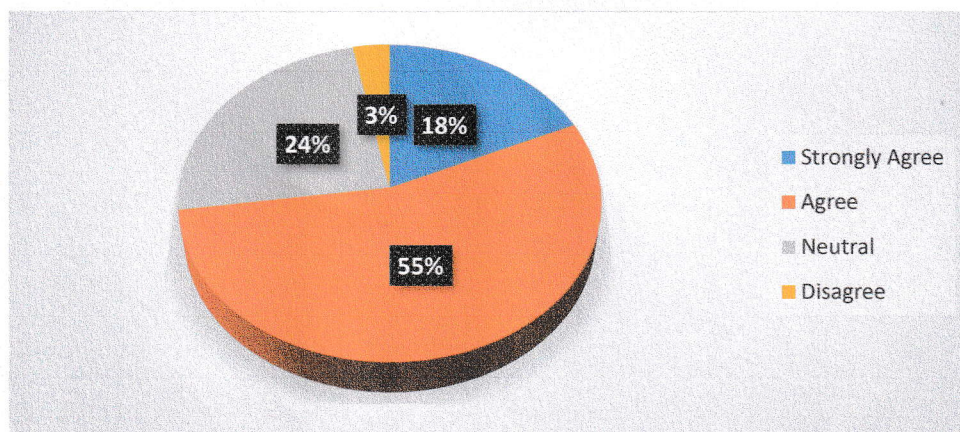


8. Courses are fully covered during the specified period

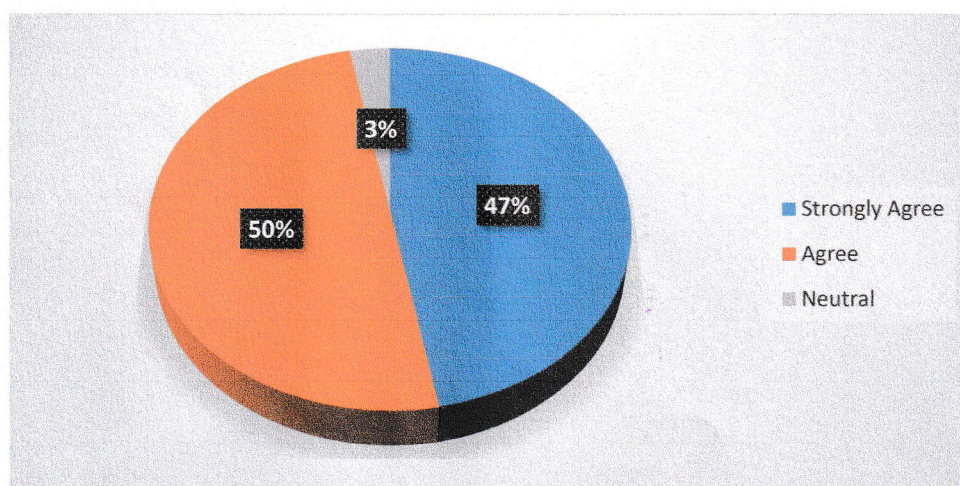




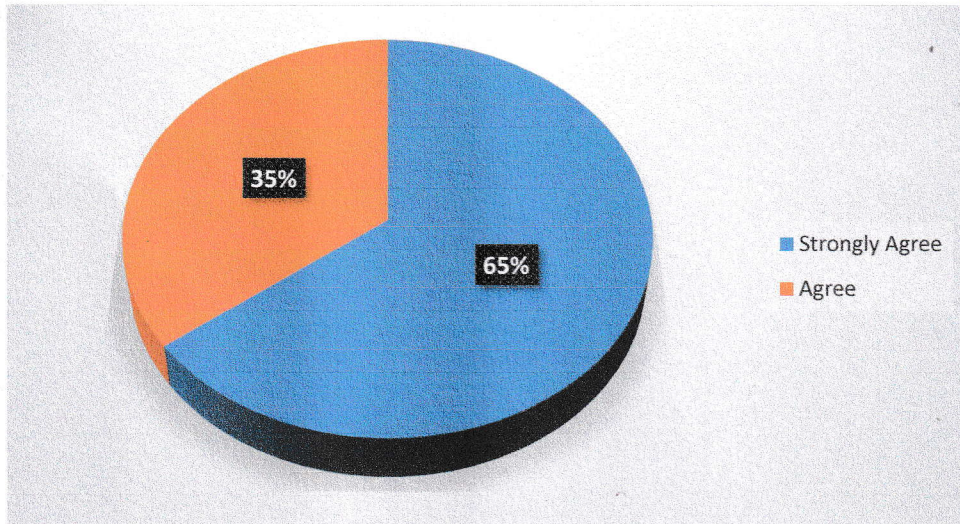
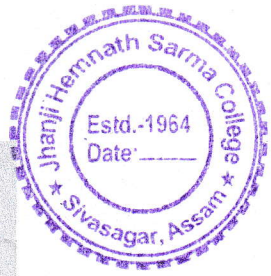
13. Explorston of academic facilities of the college such as visit to library, using of portal – N-list etc.



14. The evaluation process of students is fair and satisfactory




15. Tests, Groups Discussions, Presentation are conducted/ organized from time to time for the students




16. Suggestions given by the faculty members to add value to the existing academic environment of the college:
