The Institute provides an encouraging environment for promotion and innovation. All required facilities are provided and guidance is extended to the students. Students are encouraged to actively participate to use ICT and present their seminar through PPT. Every department publish a wall magazine and student participate in various publication for developing the creativity of the students. They are encouraged to write research-based seminar paper. Students are also trained up to search book in Archive and other OER. The Research, Innovation and Extension Cell have already signed up a MOU with Assam Rajiv Gandhi University of Co-operative Management, Sivasagar for promoting entrepreneurship quality of the students. Workshop like Entrepreneurship Development has been organised by the initiative of both institutions. The Career Counselling Cell, IQAC also organised a workshop on Entrepreneurship Development. Department of Commerce, Economics, Sociology has started certificate courses on Tea Nursery Management, Entrepreneurship development, soft skills and Personality development, Health care personals etc. Language Research Cell and Social Science Research cell organised different types of innovative activities like workshop on Creative writing, Research article preparation etc. among the interested students timely. These Cells provide financial assistance to the students and faculty members to extend their research works. The Green Club takes initiative to make the college campus green with the motto "Keep Clean, Go Green". A course on Vermicompost has been started by Green Club among the degree students for converting biodegradable waste into natural manure. Cultural club, Sports Club and literary club are established for giving special interest to the students.

The Institution has tried to create Holistic environment and positive mindset by conducting Morning Assembly in the College. A student is selected as the "Student of the Day" on the basis of Quiz asked in the morning Assembly every day. Every Friday a selected student delivers a speech about the life and works of a distinguish person in the morning assembly itself. The NSS, NCC and Green Club organise different types of cleanliness drive among the students on time-to-time basis. The library of the college has been serving through Mobile Library since the year 2017. Through this library service local people of the Institution will be benefited. It covers almost 25 families. The Institution has planned to make itself self-financed through Composite Farming, Agaru plantation etc. The Institute takes initiative to make aware its family in protecting the environment through Rain Harvesting, Installing Solar Energy etc. The Institute organises different types of awareness Programme like Cyber Crime, say no to plastic etc. An elibrary is also in developing stage through the e-resources gathered during the Covid pandemic

period in Jhanji Hemnath Sarma College. An Institution Innovation Council (IIC) to promote innovation in the Institution through multitudinous modes leading to an innovation promotion eco-system in the campus has been formed.

**Morning Assembly:** Morning Assembly is a very important part of an educational institution. Every Friday a selected student delivers a speech about the life and works of a distinguish person in the morning assembly itself.



**Mobile Library:** The Central Library of the college has been serving through Mobile Library since the year 2017. It helps to shape new ideas and perspective that are central to a creative and innovative society. This mobile library service creates opportunities for learning to support literacy and education among the neighbourhood community. Through this service books are delivered at the doorsteps of the people and in due time the books are collected from the doorsteps. This facility covers almost 25 families.





Research Cell: Jhanji Hemnath Sarma College has established two Research Cells for inculcating the research environment in the institution. Social Science Research Cell and Language Research Cell organise different types of research activities like workshops on preparation of Seminar Paper/ research Article etc. and Faculty Development Programme among the students and teachers. Both the Cell organises field trip to historical places and encourage students to write field study report so that the writing skill can be developed. Both Cells provides financial assistance to student researcher as well as teacher researchers.





**Extension Cell**: The College has established extension cells viz., National Service Scheme (NSS), National Cadet Crops (NCC) and Green Club. The NSS and NCC always organise different types of cleanliness drive, Health awareness camp, plantation programme in adopted villages. A course on Vermi-Compost has been started by Green Club among the degree students for converting biodegradable waste into natural manure.





**Women Cell**: The College has established women Cell to empower the women in society through education. This Cell was established in the year 2004. The women cell organises different types of programmes like Health Awareness camp, Mental Hygiene programme, Menstrual Hygiene programme, women's day in adopted villages. The cell also organises literary and cultural competition among the students of the college.

Dr Montu Kumar Bora – Cultural Club






**Rain Water Harvesting & Solar Energy**: The Institute takes initiative to spread Environment protection awareness through Rain Harvesting, Installing Solar Energy etc. The College has installed 4 rain water preservers and two mini solar plates and one solar panel for preserving solar energy.





**Use of ICT:** Due to increase in strength of students studying in Photoshop, web-designed, frequent changes in the curriculum and rapid development in the field of IT sector, the college has also enhanced the IT facilities with Wi-Fi. At present, there are 85 computers in the college. For maintenance of the computers and other IT facilities, the college has an attendant who manages the networking and troublesome of computer systems and other accessories. The IT facilities of the college includes computers, laptops, printers, scanners, projectors, Interactive teaching box, pen drives, Android mobile phones for capturing photos, making videos etc. During COVID-19 period without interruption of regular classes, students were monitored and involved through online classes using different platforms viz. Microsoft Teams, Google classroom, WhatsApp, Google Meet etc. Moreover, the college tries to improve the slow learners and the intended students through digital learning in the digital classroom. In addition to this, NSDC provides three months computer skill to all the students of the college.





**Publication Cell:** The College has two Research Cell viz., Language Research Cell and Social Science Research Cell to develop the Research culture in college campus. The both cells organise workshop on Creative writing, research paper and article writing etc. The cells also organise state or district level student seminar amongst the students. It offers a scholarship of Rs.25,000/- to student researcher as well as teacher researcher in order to conduct the research work whenever needed. The social science research Cell recommends different research topics and guides for applying Major/Minor Research Projects.
